JOB DESCRIPTION

JOB-TITLE - FIREFIGHTER

JOB STATUS - VOLUNTEER

The following position description is established by the Board of Directors of the Greater Brighton Fire Protection District to outline the basic requirement, duties, and responsibilities of the above captioned position. This position is an "at-will", volunteer position for which no compensation is paid, and to which the FLSA has no application.

POSITION SUMMARY:

Under the supervision and direction of the District's Command Structure, the Firefighter performs a variety of duties associated with the District's Emergency Response Programs. The programs provide for all emergent and non-emergent responses for fire suppression, rescue, hazardous materials mitigation, and emergency medical assistance. The Firefighter may on occasion be responsible for public services related to enforcement and education of all appropriate codes and standards, operational preplanning, and public education as related to life and property safety values within the community.

REPORTING RELATIONSHIPS:

The Firefighter reports directly to the Lieutenant of the assigned Company, or as appropriately assigned within an Incident Command.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Firefighting at all levels of a functional structure, requires skills in combating, extinguishing and preventing fire, and in answering emergency alarms. The Firefighter's work requires extensive training in the performance of firefighting, rescue, hazardous materials, and emergency medical assistance. The primary duties and responsibilities of a Firefighter include, but are not limited to:

1. Consistently promote a professional image of the Fire District during performance of all duties
2. Successfully complete all required training as necessary to meet the duties of the position.
3. Understand and follow detailed oral and written instructions or superior officer commands.
4. Clearly and concisely communicate, both verbally and in writing, information necessary to successfully complete all duties and responsibilities.
5. Interact and coordinate in a positive and professional manner with other personnel, career or volunteer, of the District.
6. Maintain awareness of, and compliance with, all Rules, Regulations, and Operating Procedures of the District.
7. Attend all District meetings and training sessions as determined by the Command Structure of the District.

8. Maintain a current awareness of District streets, roads, and address systems.
9. Maintain all District-required certifications and training requirements.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES:

None

SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

1. Have knowledge of the streets and road systems of the District
2. Have knowledge of the general physical layout of the District and its boundaries.
3. Have the knowledge and skills to perform a variety of fire suppression duties and methods.
4. Have the knowledge and skills to perform a variety of rescue duties and methods.
5. Have the knowledge and skills to perform and/or assist medical emergency duties and methods.
6. Have the ability to competently and safely operate District vehicles and equipment as appropriately trained and assigned.
7. Ability to assist in minor maintenance of District apparatus, tools and equipment as well as perform appropriate upkeep efforts as trained and assigned by the District.
8. Ability to assist in the maintenance and upkeep of appropriate areas within the stations and facilities of the District as trained.
9. Drive and operate privately owned vehicles in response to stations and incidents related to District operations as determined appropriate by the District and its Command Personnel.
10. Respond to alarms and perform according to established District training standards, basic firefighting, and rescue and medical guidelines and protocols.
11. Perform all related duties and assignments as directed from time to time
12. Ability to communicate clearly and concisely both verbally and in writing.
13. Ability to recognize human behavior traits and utilize appropriate interpersonal dynamic skills to achieve positive outcomes within a broad range of people.
14. Ability to demonstrate effective problem solving skills through a systematic approach.
15. Ability to successfully complete the required entry "academy" training, including rescue technology as specified by the District.
16. Ability to successfully complete the required minimum training in hazardous materials mitigation as specified by the District.
17. Ability to successfully complete the required minimum training in emergency medical methods as specified by the District.

SPECIAL MATERIALS AND/OR EQUIPMENT UTILIZED IN PERFORMANCE OF DUTIES:

1. Operate District vehicles of all types, including emergency response units, as trained and assigned.
2. Operate firefighting hand tools, power tools, and hose-lines as trained.
3. Operate specialized powered extrication tools and equipment.
4. Operate in and function with self-contained breathing apparatus.
5. Operate in and function with personal protective clothing and equipment.

SPECIAL MENTAL AND PHYSICAL PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS:

1. Physically capable of performing all duties as set forth in NFPA 1582.
2. Mentally capable of performing all duties as set forth in NFPA 1582.

EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

1. High School Diploma or GED equivalent.
2. Colorado State Certification - Fire Fighter 1 minimum
3. Colorado State Certification - Emergency Medical First Responder
4. Colorado Hazardous Materials Certification - Operations Level
5. American Heart or equivalent Certification - CPR

REQUISITE STANDARDS:

1. Capable of performing with a typical shift schedule as described by District policy.
2. Possession of a valid Colorado Driver's License
3. Capable of passing an extensive background evaluation, including but not limited to, driver's license check, criminal conviction check, certification, degree and/or diploma verification, and reference contact.
